Fosters

All our adoptable kittens and cats stay in our wonderful volunteer foster homes that give them love and care while waiting for their forever homes. NVHS funds all authorized medical care, and provides food, litter, and other supplies if assistance is needed.

Intake-to-Adoption Coordinators

- Document our rescues through to adoption
- Help coordinate veterinary visits, track appointments needed
- Gather information from fosters to help with purrfect placements
- Coordinate required medical documentation to adopters

Trappers

- Help rescue cats who need medical care, spay/neuter
- For feral TNR, transport to appointments and maintain cats 24-48 hours for recovery before release (if possible, but not required)

Seniors for Seniors Program Assistants (any of the following)

- Assume responsibility for overseeing the care of a portion of our roster of Senior Program Adopters/Cats
- Schedule home visits and vet appointments
- Conduct/assist with home visits (nail trims, grooming, food/supplies delivery)
- Transport cats/adopters to vet appointments, including emergencies
- Develop database to maintain records of program cats
- Develop promotional materials and conduct outreach at senior centers/senior housing facilities

Documentation Specialist

Help update, coordinate, and create informative, educational and training documents for our volunteers, fosters, adopters, and public
